Xenia Avenue Ground Breaking Ceremony

Beaumont, CA—On Thursday, October 5, 2017 the City of Beaumont will host a ground breaking ceremony for the Xenia Avenue Street Improvement Project.

The project will include complete reconstruction of Xenia Avenue from 6th Street to 8th Street. In addition to reconstruction and widening, sidewalks will be installed on the west side of the street to expand pedestrian access to 6th Street. In concurrence with Xenia Avenue, Oak Valley Parkway will also begin seeing improvements with a grind and overlay project. Improvements will take place between Cherry Avenue and Beaumont Avenue and include installation of curb and gutter where missing.
